Helpful Hints:

- All skaters should arrive 30 minutes before each class starts. Please allow more time on the first day of class.
- We recommend that skaters dress warmly and in layers. Gloves or mittens are recommended.
- Helmets are not provided but are recommended for beginner skaters. Bicycle helmets are fine!
- Ice skates should fit snugly and should be one size smaller than the skater's shoe size. A comfortable fit allows for the skater's toes to wiggle and thin socks are recommended.
- Before purchasing skates please consult one of our professionals to help you choose the most appropriate skate for the level.
- All classes are designated by colored signs located on the back glass of the rink. Skaters should meet their instructors at the same location each week. During the 1st week, Snow Plow 1 & 2 meet off ice, then go to their pre-assigned lane together.
- Hockey classes require the following additional equipment: hockey gloves, shin guards, elbow pads and a helmet with cage. Please consult one of our professionals for assistance on purchases of equipment.
- We encourage parents to watch classes but request that your presence does not distract the skaters.

Introduction

The *Palm Beach Ice Works Learn to Skate Program* will be taught by our world class coaching staff using the Basic Skating Skills program. The goal is to provide a fun, safe atmosphere for all students (ages 3 and above) to learn how to ice skate.

The Basic Skating Skills program was developed by U.S. Figure Skating, the national governing body of skating on ice in the United States. U.S. Figure Skating is a member of the International Skating Union (ISU) and a member of the United States Olympic Committee.

Program Fundamentals

The best program of its kind, the Basic Skills Program consists of a comprehensive lesson/test structure that is exciting, rewarding, safe and fun. It has proven to be an overwhelming success across the United States.

There are 9 program levels: **Snow Plow Sam through Basic 8.**

The levels are geared toward teaching the fundamentals of skating which will help the skater develop the skills that are necessary for recreational, figure, ice hockey, and speed skating.

A skater who wants to learn how to play hockey will go through the levels Basic 1 to 4. Hockey skills will be introduced at Basic 5 and upon graduating Basic 6 the skater will then be prepared to sign up for the 8 week Learn to Play Hockey program. This program is designed to bridge the skater's progress from learn to skate to figure skating.

Skating Levels of Advancement

Snow Plow Sam = Designed for first time skaters who require more attention and confidence before progressing to Pre-Alpha. A skating walker may accompany a skater during this time.

Basic 1-2 = Two foot glides, one foot glides and basic backward skating.

Basic 3-4 = Forward stroking, forward crossovers and snowplow stops.

Basic 5-6 = Intro to Hockey, backward stroking, backward crossovers and T-stops.

Basic 7-8 = Learn to Play Hockey, basic turns from forward to backward.

** All other Freestyle levels will be evaluated by an instructor.*
